

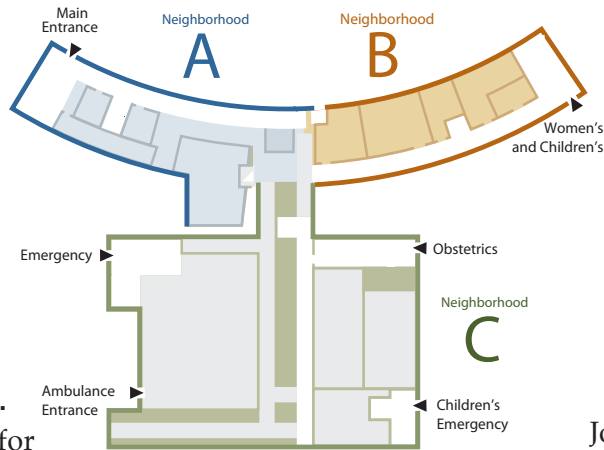
# We made visiting our neighborhoods as easy as A, B, C.

The new Virtua Voorhees Hospital is designed so patients and visitors can easily access the services they need. The hospital is divided into “neighborhoods”, each with a designated parking area, entrance, lobby and elevators.

## Neighborhoods A, B and C.

Patients who are admitted for medical or surgical reasons proceed to neighborhood A. Patients requiring services in the Women’s and Children’s Pavilion head to neighborhood B. And obstetrics patients arriving for labor and delivery or maternal fetal medicine services will enter at neighborhood C. Every department has been carefully located so that related services are adjacent to one another for easy patient access.

Patients will stay in private rooms flooded with daylight and have views of the natural landscape. Each room incorporates a family area where primary caregivers can spend the night if desired. Each patient has his own



flat screen TV with internet access. The TV system enables patients to access meal menus, health information and education, or watch TV and movies.

## Family comfort is also a priority to enhance healing.

The hospital is comfortable for visitors as well. Family waiting areas are conveniently placed throughout the hospital. A dining area, café, shops and a meditation room are available on the Garden Level.

In milder weather, visitors may dine on the Garden Patio, and OB patients and parents of babies in the NICU can access rooftop gardens.

Sunlight floods the building through skylights and the décor throughout the hospital is soothing. The entire structure is designed to enhance healing, to nurture patients and create a family-centered environment.
