# VISITOR INFORMATION



**Your health and well-being are our highest priorities. At Virtua, we are following Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and New Jersey Department of Health guidelines to reduce the spread of COVID-19. We take infection prevention seriously and have taken extra precautions to ensure Virtua is doing everything we can to minimize any risk to our patients, staff, and visitors.**

- ▶ Visitors will perform hand hygiene and complete a screening tool for COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival at our facilities.
- ▶ Visitors will have their temperature taken. If your temperature is greater than 100.0 F, or you are showing other symptoms relating to COVID-19, we will ask you to leave and return after you are fever and symptom free for 72 hours.
- ▶ Visitors may only go directly to the patient's room and remain in the patient's room at all times. We are not allowing visitors in the our hallways, cafeterias, coffee shops, gift shops, or other public areas.
- ▶ Visitors are required to wear a face mask at all times while within our facilities. An ear loop mask will be provided to each visitor to be used for the entire visitation. If the mask we provide is loose fitting, please wear your own mask on top of it. Additionally, the patient must also wear a mask (if tolerated) while the visitor is in the room.
- ▶ Visitors may be asked to step inside a designated waiting area when the patient they are visiting is receiving treatment.
